TERMS & CONDITIONS

Season passes remain the property of Swain. This pass is for your personal use only. Transferring or improper use of this pass will result in loss of pass privileges for the season and is punishable under NY State Law. Season Pass must be worn on the outside of clothing and be highly visible at all times to ski area personnel.

If the season pass is forgotten, pass-holder will be required to purchase a full rate ticket. No complimentary lift tickets will be issued. Lost passes must be reported to the Skier Service Office immediately. No replacement pass will be issued.

Swain has the right under Article 18 of the New York State Obligations Law to remove from the ski area and/or deny skiing privileges to anyone whose conduct, excesses or attitudes, as determined by Management or Ski Patrol create a nuisance for themselves or others. In such cases no refunds shall be issued.

A family for purposes of a family season pass includes head of household and/or spouse and legal children under the age of 18 or a full time student with proof of enrollment. All family members other than head of household and/or spouse must be legal dependants under 18 years of age or full time undergraduate students and/or claimed on IRS income tax forms as a dependant to qualify for a family season pass.

Notice: Skiers, Snowboarders, and ski lift passengers are governed by the New York State Safety in Skiing Code, Article 18 of the NYS Obligations Law. Before affixing your pass or allowing any pass to be affixed to your person, your attention is directed to a posted "Warning to Skiers" which is displayed where tickets are purchased. New York State Law requires you to seek, read, review and understand the "Warning to Skiers" before you decide to participate in the sport of skiing.

REFUND POLICY

For passes purchased, issued, and activated prior to the close of the 2007/2008 Snowsports Season a full refund will be issued for the total amount of money paid for any reason less a per diem prorated amount based on operating days from the date of pass issuance to the date of refund request. For passes purchased, issued, or activated after the close of 2007/2008 snowsports season and before the 2008/2009 season opens, a full refund will be issued for the total amount of money paid for any reason, less \$35 service charge. For passes issued and activated after the open of the 2008/2009 season no refunds will be issued. Allow 30 days for processing either form of refund or credit.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

- Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It's your responsibility to avoid them.
- You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
